- The school gates are closed at 10.15 a.m. and late-comers sometimes may not be permitted to enter into the school.
- The parents should take their Wards within 10 minutes after dismissal of classes.
- The class will start from 10.35 a.m. and will continue as per class routine.

TRANSPORTATION:

Academy provides bus facilities to the students in some routes against the payment of charges. The Private vehicles are available on certain radius. Information in respect of charges, timing, pick up point etc. can be obtained from the Accounts Section of the School and all the charges would be paid in advance who require facilities.

EVALUATION & ASSESSMENT:

The School conducts three Semesters during the academic year after completion of the respective syllabus for each semester. The promotion of a student will be determined on the basis of his/her total performance during the academic year.

ASSESSMENT AND PROMOTION:

1. Promotion at the end of the year will be based on a total continuous assessment in every subject, on the work done during the year.
2. The report cards should be duly signed by the guardian.
3. 90% of attendance is required to sit for the final examination.
4. Progress Report of tests and examinations will be shown to the parents.
5. A student who fails in any subject or misses an examination will not be allowed for supplementary test.
6. Application for verification of marks will not be entertained.
7. Breach of any of the regulations of conduct or the use of unfair means discovered at the examination will merit the cancellation of the particular paper and the student concerned will be awarded a zero. And if such misconduct is repeated, he will be expelled from the entire examination.
8. In all questions of promotion or failure, the principal's decision is final and it cannot be reconsidered.

LEAVE AND ABSENCE:

1. Parent/Guardian should avoid taking children on long holidays during the working days. There is no procedure to grant permission for such absence or grant leave and should treat as absent.
2. Total number of working days is approximately 225 days. Students must obtain 75% attendance applicable, failing which they may be debarred from taking the examinations which is the pre-requisite condition for the student to sit for Annual Examination for all classes. The school reserves the right to withhold a student from appearing in all the Examinations and also in the Annual Examination or withhold promotion in case the minimum attendance requirement is not fulfilled.
3. The school seeks co-operation from parents in exercising utmost discretion in excusing children from school.

4. If a student is absent from school for one day, the attendance record provided in the dairy should be duly filled by the Parents/Guardian and submitted to the teacher. However, a student absent from school for more than one day must submit on application stating the reason for his absence written briefly and duly signed by his parents. All such application must be addressed to the principal and submitted on the first day of the child's re-joining school.
5. If a student is absent for more than two consecutive days or on any Friday, his parents must meet with the principal to explain the reasons for the absence.
6. In case of long-term illness, the Parent/Guardian must personally inform the Principal and the Class Teacher about the nature and likely durations of the student's illness. A medical certificate in original (not prescription) should be submitted along with the application for leave.
7. Children learners afflicted with contagious or infectious disease or exposed to such disease in their homes must complete the quarantine period before joining school. No student afflicted with any such disease will be permitted to attend the school till he brings medical certificate of fitness and/or the school gets the child examined and finds him fit.
8. Parents/Guardians are expected to plan their holidays/travel plans, family functions, etc. coincide during the time of school vacations. Leave for the same during the season will not be sanctioned.
9. Parents/Guardians are expected to maintain their part in enforcing regularity punctuality and discipline.
10. School hour on all working days are from 10.00 a.m. will continue till end of the routine of the class or extended hours. The Principal can meet with the parents on working days with prior appointment only. No school business will be transacted on Saturday, Sundays and holidays but it may withdraw as per notice of the Principal or designated Officer.

ATTENDANCE IS COMPULSORY ON:

1. The students must remain present on the opening and closing day of Vacation, (Summer, Durga puja, Diwali, Christmas/Winter) and each term examination.
2. In the School events such as Sports Day, speech Day, Birth of Day of Swami Vivekananda, Birth Day of the Vivekananda Academy, Independence Day, Republic Day, birth day of National leaders etc. and designated observance days, cultural and literacy programme viz. Music and Dance, Debate, Drama, Elocution, Essay Written, Drawing, Recitation, Quiz, Exhibition, Saraswati Puja, Sports meet/ Concert practices or Extra Classes etc. and also as per instructions of the Principal or any other designated person.
3. **Failing which he/she is liable to pay a fine of ₹20.00 (Rupees Twenty Only) for each day and to be deposited with the monthly Tuition Fees.**
4. Absence or treating the leave as leave: No leave will be granted if the student absent from the First day/ Last day after/ before the vacation and from School Events like Annual Programmes/Sports/Saturday Activities /Class Visits and in the case of absence in reasons has to be justified. Before or after the vacation full day attendance is compulsory for all the students.
5. All working Saturday, if scheduled, attendance is compulsory for all the students failing which the absentees without valid reasons will be treated from absence from coming to School for one Week.
6. Under normal circumstances, in the case of medical reasons, school only accepts medical Certificate of Allopathic registered medical practitioner (MBBS) only supported with prescription, test reports and medicine bills, as authentication of student's absence from School.

STUDIES AND EXAMINATIONS:

Every student should devote a lot of time for study and give himself/herself enough time to prepare his/her daily lessons.

- At the end of each term, students will be examined in the matter studied during the term.
- To pay separately examination fees, Saraswati Puja charges.

- To pass an examination, a student should obtain a minimum of 40% in each subject. He/she should secure 90% or above to get a distinction.
- The students will be liable to clear the dues before issuance of admit card positively otherwise he/she will not be allowed to sit in the respective examination and no separate examination will be taken by the school.
- Any student who obtains or gives dishonest help during an examination will not be allowed to continue with remaining examination thereafter.

ADMISSION:

For the Academic Session 2026-2027, admission will remain open to Boys & Girls from Junior KG to Class IX & XI.

- Admission fee payment must be made at the time of Admission with one month Tuition fee.
- Admission for a particular year is neither refundable or transferable to any other year.

ADMISSION PROCESS:

The eligibility criterion for various classes is based on the child's age. For the next academic year, the applicant's age as of 31st March 2026 as recorded in the birth certificate, will determine the eligibility for admission to a particular class.

Recommended Age Criteria for Admission in the are as follows: -

The parents/guardians will have to collect Prospectus for the year 2026-2027 against payment of ₹300 (Non-refundable) during office hours wherein Application Form and others details are available in the prospectus.

The duly filled forms should be submitted to Accounts, Section of the school within 07 days from the date of obtaining the Prospectus. No photocopy of Application form will be accepted by the Accounts Section or by the Principal in any circumstances. Even in the case of ward of the staff of the school.

The following documents are required at the time of Admission -

- Recent photograph of the ward should be affixed on the form, four recent photographs to be handed over at the time of admission of the students for next class along with two passport size photographs of their parents/authorized guardians
- An attested copy of the birth certificate issued by the Municipality/Panchayet
- We do admit children of every caste and creed
- No child of less than 4 years admitted to Junior KG
- The student will be admitted with a Transfer Certificate from the other school last attended, if transferred from another School
- Irrespective of the time of admission, fees will be charged from the beginning of the academic session to end of the academic session i.e. 12 months

WITHDRAWAL/INFORMATION REGARDING TRANSFER CERTIFICATE:

1. Withdrawal of student from the school is not permitted for admission in other school which may issue after determining the valid cause only in the case of transfer of service from one place to another.
2. If any students are admitted in another School without clearing all the dues and/or obtaining Transfer Certificate, in that case, the School Authority shall have every right to take all legal actions/steps for realization of money receivable from the students or through the school where he/she will be admitted and the school will not issue the Transfer Certificate after admission in another school.
3. A written notice of one calendar month is to be given by the parents/ guardians to the Principal before obtaining a transfer certificate for admission in another school.
4. No transfer certificate will be issued to any student until all dues to the school are paid in full.
5. In case of an Emergency, the Principal may apply his/her discretionary power to issue the Transfer Certificate to a student within 7 days from the date of such application from the parent/guardian concerned. In such a case the parent/guardian shall have to pay the subsequent month's fees, along with all dues, if any.
6. Three month's tuition fees and Annual charges (Session) will be charged if a request for a Transfer Certificate/withdrawal is made at any time within 3 months after reopening of the new academic session/ after taking admission.
7. The transfer certificate charges is ₹500/- payable at the Account Office before submitting the application for the Transfer Certificate. The receipt for the same is to be attached to the application.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION:

- Self-attested photo copy of the birth certificate from competent authority and AADHAAR CARD and the transfer certificate in original. Income certificate /Declaration
- Self-attested photo copy of the SC or ST or OBC certificate
- Certificate obtained from the previous school which is essential at the time of admission.
- Parents photo 4 (2+2) copies
- Students photo 4 copies
- Medical certificate with blood group certified by the Doctor not below M.B.B.S required for issuance of Identity Card
- Result of last examination with valid transfer certificate

ACADEMIC SESSION:

From April to March of the next calendar year.

EXAMINATION:

Before issuance of the Admit Card for the Terminal Examination, Half Yearly Examination and Annual Examinations all dues should be cleared before issuance of Admit Card for the respective examinations.

GAMES & SPORTS:

The Games & Sports and Physical Exercise are compulsory under the supervision of the qualified teacher/instructor. In each year, Annual Sports meet are organized as per schedule to be determined. The students are always encouraged for participation of the social service activities.

ANNUAL FUNCTION:

The school organized Annual Function with the active participation of the students preferably and the capable selected students participate in the function, parents, well-wisher and the local people are invited to encourage the students and enjoy all activities of the students.

EXCURSION & PICNIC:

In each year, the school organized an Excursion for the students and/or Picnic for the students for which separate charges will be applicable.

REGULARITY RECORD:

- The student should reach in the school campus within 10.00 a.m.
- School begins with the Prayer/ Assembly at 10.15 a.m. and students must be on time for it and be present in the Assembly as mentioned separately.
- A fine will be charged @ ₹5.00 per day in case of absence without sanction of leave. The Fine will be added with the tuition fee for the month.

EARLY DEPARTURE:

- Early departure is availed when there is an emergency at home or when a student gets sick in the school and in both the cases the parents will have to submit the application to the Principal or his absence to the Designated person for their consideration.

FEE STRUCTURE:

- **Fees** – The school and other fee dues are to be paid before the 12th of every month. Payment made after 12th will invite a fine discussed in another point **failing which a late fee of ₹5/- will be levied up to the end of month and thereafter ₹10/- per month cumulatively** and it will continue accordingly till payment of tuition fees.
- **All students from Classes VI to X will have to deposit ₹1000/- and ₹2000/- for Class IX to XtII will have to deposit as Security Deposit at the beginning of their scholastic year.**
- Security Deposit will be returned back without interest at the time of leaving the Academy against the production of receipt for the same and after deduction amount for the loss of any articles by him/ her in any form in laboratory, Library and others, if any.
- No reduction is made for holidays or absence period students are liable to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls.
- Fees and others once paid will not be refunded in any reasons even in the case of transfer of the student from the School after Admission/Re-admission.
- Fees for the holiday's months must be paid in advance before the school closes.
- Deduction will be made from Security Deposit for breakages and damages (if any), and the balance if any, will be refunded to the parents without interest when their wards leave the school. Receipt of Security Deposit must be produced for refund.
- The school reserves the right to increase the Tuition Fees and other Fees Subscription Fees at any time of the year if considered necessary.
- Fee should be deposited in cash without fine in the Accounts Section.
- Fee with fine is to be paid in the school Accounts Section only.
- The outstanding dues should be cleared before all the term exams, half yearly examination and annual examination.

- Payment made through mobile transfer through any teacher will not be accepted by the Accounts Department and the entire responsibility lying with the Guardian.
- Parents should retain the receipts issued to them and produce them as proof of payment as and when required specially before issuance of Admit Card for payment of respective examinations fees who wish to make the payment of monthly tuition fees through any other person which will not be accepted by the School.
- The last date for the payment of fees without fine has been mentioned in the School Diary.
- No concession in admission fees/Books/Dresses will be given in the name of two or more children coming from the same family except the deserving candidate.
- Underprivileged Children/Student will be concession in tuition only.
- School fees are calculated for a twelve-month cycle.
- No concession in admission fees/yearly fees will be given to the wards of any Staff and no concession fees in monthly tuition fees will be given.

REGULARITY & CONDUCT:

SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS -

VIVEKANADA ACADEMY has developed disciplinary norms which reflect the **school's basic principles and aims.**

1. Special importance is given to nourish moral values and self-discipline among the students.
2. The enrolment of the student concerned may be terminated in case of unauthorised, unjustified or unexplained absence, irregular attendance, disobedience or objectionable behaviour in school premises.
3. No students will be allowed to leave the school campus during school hours without prior permission of the school authority.
4. Parents are not allowed to see their wards or meet teachers during class hours without the special permission of the Principal/ In-charge/Co-ordinator.
5. No student will be allowed in the school premises without the prescribed Uniform whenever they step into the school premises and they must come to school in proper uniform.
6. It is compulsory for students to speak in English within the school campus.
7. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their own belongings.
8. Bringing gadgets or device is strictly prohibited, If the students bring the above items, it will be seized as non-refundable items and the Academy will destroy the same without showing any reason or cause either to the student or his/her parents or guardians;
9. Bringing of mobile phones, tab, head phone or any other electronic devices, forbidden books, magazines are strictly prohibited inside the school premises.
10. Destruction or damaging of school property is a punishable offence. Guardians are liable to pay the cost of the school property broken, or damaged by their child.
11. Students should not come to school wearing valuable ornaments and carrying of excess money over and above ₹100/- is not allowed.
12. Students are responsible for the safe custody of their own books and belongings.
13. Each article of the student must be legibly marked with the student's Name, Class and Section.
14. The students should attend the School on the Closing and Opening day of the vacation or any other leave for continuing days.
15. Parents and Guardians are not allowed to meet their wards or interview teachers during school hours except in the office for payment of tuition fees or any other fees. The parents/guardians may meet with the Teachers after prior permission of the Principal/In-charge/Co-ordinator after School hour.

16. Gifts to the members of the staff in cash or kind is not allowed except with the permission of the Principal/In-charge/Co-ordinator.
17. The date of birth of a student once entered shall not be changed.
18. Student must possess a copy of the school diary which is to be brought on all working days.
